1. Judge Bowman called the meeting to order.
2. Discussion was held regarding an Interlocal Agreement with the Goliad Independent School District for the collection of county taxes pursuant to chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code. Judge Bowman read the estimated projections for Goliad County Independent School District to collect the county taxes, **as appears in ATTACHMENT #1.**

County Tax Assessor/Collector, Anna Lopez said she has come to a decision based on public input that she is not going to approve the contract to consolidate taxing entities between Goliad County and Goliad Independent School District.

Harold Gleinser said we need to save as much money as we can for Goliad County and Anna Lopez has done a great job all these years.

Art Dohmann agrees with Gleinser and said there are a number of options that can benefit the county that we need to look into in the future.



Without approval from the County Tax Assessor/Collector no further action can be taken.


