



The Goliad County Commissioners Court will meet at 9:05 A.m. Monday, March 23, in an emergency session to consider extending the Emergency Disaster Declaration issued by County Judge Mike Bennett on March 17. By state law, the Emergency Declaration issued by a county judge is valid for only seven days and must be extended by action of the Commissioners Court to have it continue.

The disaster declaration was put in place to allow Goliad County to access funds and resources that could be needed for issues caused by the coronavirus pandemic.

As always, the public and media are welcome to attend. This is expected to be a very short meeting, and the disaster extension is the only item on the agenda.
