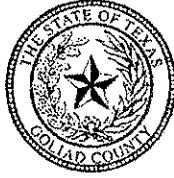

## DECLARATION OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the County of Goliad, on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2021, and continuing through the present, and expected to continue for the next several days, has experienced extremely severe winter weather that has resulted in widespread and/or severe damage, injury or loss of life or property, and poses an imminent threat of additional widespread and severe property damage, injury or loss of life or property due to prolonged sub-freezing temperatures, freezing rain, and snow throughout the county that has resulted in thousands of residents being without power for several days; and,


WHEREAS, the County Judge of Goliad County has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF GOLIAD COUNTY, TEXAS:

1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for Goliad County pursuant to Section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. Pursuant to Section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven (7) days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Commissioners Court of Goliad County.
3. Pursuant to Section 418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk.
4. Pursuant to Section 418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the county emergency management plan.
5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
