RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF GOLIAD COUNTY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT - MITIGATION PROJECT APPLICATION TO THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE TO ACT AS THE COUNTY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE COUNTY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT & REVITALIZATION PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Goliad County desires to develop a thriving, viable community, strengthen infrastructure, provide a suitable living environment, and expand economic opportunities, principally for persons of low-to-moderate income; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interest of Goliad County to apply for funding under the Community Development Block Grant Mitigation Program;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED;

Section 1. That a Community Development Block Grant Program application is hereby authorized to be filed with the Texas General Land Office for funding consideration under the Community **Development Block Grant - Mitigation Program; and**

Section 2. That the application be for the CDBG-MIT Program through the Competition or Method of Distribution Application program to carry out Infrastructure Activities; and

Section 3. That the grant amount be up to the maximum allowed by the CDBG-MIT program and may include a minimum one percent (1%) match; and

Section 4. That the Commissioners Court directs and designates the County Judge as the Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and participation in the Community Development & Revitalization Grant Program.
