

REQUIREMENTS FOR TRAILER TITLE AND REGISTRATION

Effective September 1, 2011, as required by Texas Department of Motor Vehicles, all non-titled trailers being registered as homemade or shop made will require an assigned serial number. Titled trailers without a visible or legible Manufacturers' VIN number will require a re-assigned serial number. Identifying serial numbers will aid in the recovery of property in the event that it is stolen and will prevent confiscation by law enforcement.

ASSIGNMENT

Once inspection is completed by law enforcement agency, the forms listed below should be taken in or mailed to the TXDMV Regional Service Center at **1701 SPID Bldg.2**, **Corpus Christi**, **TX 78416**.

The following is required by TX DMV for assignment of serial number(s):

- Completed VTR 68-A
- 2. Weight Certificate (empty)
- 3. Full view photo of trailer(s)
- 4. \$2.00 fee

RE-ASSIGNMENT

Once inspection is completed by law enforcement agency, the forms listed below MUST be taken in to the TXDMV Regional Service Center at **1701 SPID Bldg.2**, **Corpus Christi, TX 78416**.

The following is required by TX DMV for **re-assignment** of serial number(s):

- Completed VTR 68-A
- 2. Weight Certificate (empty)
- 3. Full view photo of trailer(s)
- 4. Evidence of ownership (Title, Manufacturers' Certificate of Origin or Court Order)
- 5. \$2.00 fee

Owner will be issued or provided a serial number along with form VTR 68-N. All documents received by TXDMV should be surrendered to your local tax office at the time of titling or registration. **Trailers over 4,000 lbs MUST be inspected and titled.** A Title, Manufacturers' Certificate of Origin or Court Order is REQUIRED.
