ORDER SETTING TAX RATES AND LEVYING TAXES

On the 23rd day of September, 2019, at a meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Goliad County, Texas, the Court considered setting tax rates for the 2020 fiscal tax year. The Court found that the 2020 rates will be 67.19614 cents for the general operating fund and 9.99715 cents for Road and Bridge, both per \$100 valuation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the tax rates for the 2020 fiscal tax year are 67.19614 cents for the general operating fund and 9.99715 cents for Road and Bridge, both per \$100 valuation.

THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE. THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE DECREASED BY 2.905% AND WILL DECREASE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$2905.00.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that taxes are levied for the 2020 fiscal tax year.
